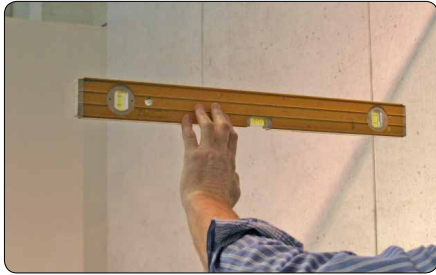
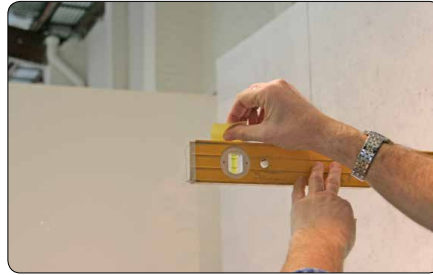


# Easy Window Graphic Installation



1. Determine the position of the graphic and use a level to ensure the graphic will be straight. (To be installed on the inside of glass).



2. Place 'sticky notes' on either side of the level to mark the position of the top edge. Make sure the sticky notes are not further apart than the graphic width.



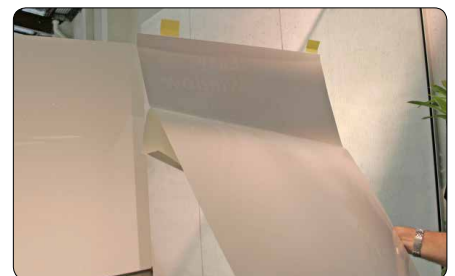
3. Peel back the top 5 centimetres of the backing film from the graphic



4. Fold back the top 5 centimetres or so of backing paper.



5. Align the top edge of the graphic to the bottom edge of the sticky notes. Press top 5 cm of graphic against the glass working from the middle outward.



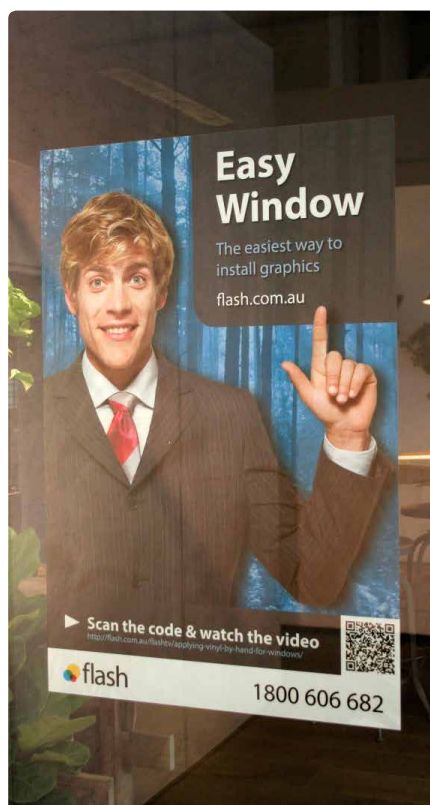
6. Peel back a section of backing paper to expose the adhesive. To minimise wrinkles do not pull away all the backing paper at once.



7. Press the exposed graphic onto the glass working from the top down and outwards. Peel back more backing paper and adhere to glass as needed until finished.
